Subject: Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH)

We hereby inform you that the company **Tiemme Raccorderie S.p.A.**, according to the REACH regulation, fits into the definition of a “Downstream User” of chemical substances and/or mixtures; hence we duly cooperate with our suppliers to implement all the necessary measures required to comply with the Regulation in question.

Our company do not produce or import any chemical substances (on their own, substances in mixtures and substances in articles), but supplies “articles”. In this regard, the Regulation requires that if those substances are present in those articles in quantities totalling over one tonne per year or are intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, those substances must be submitted to ECHA for registration.

Moreover, if the articles contain the substances of very high concern “SVHC” mentioned in the Annex XIV in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight, or those substances are present in quantities totalling over one tonne per year, those substances must be notified to the ECHA and to the customer. SVHC substances are not fully identified yet.

On the basis of the information mentioned above, Tiemme Raccorderie S.p.A.

DECLARES

that to started in 27 june of 2018 was introduced in the substances list SHVC (Substances of Very High Concern) the lead element, CAS number 7439-92-1, EC number 231-100-4:

The copper alloys used by TIEMME contain lead in concentration higher than 0,1% (p/p). TIEMME’s items contain this substance in concentration higher that 0,1 % (p/p), according to copper alloys (brass, bronze). Presence of lead in the Candidate list doesn’t change the safety conditions of our products.
